### RAINBOW

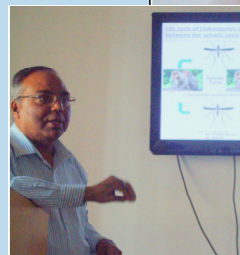
*“The drops of rain make a hole in the stone, not by violence, but by often falling” ---Lucretius*

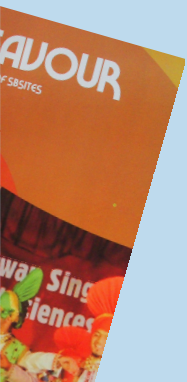
