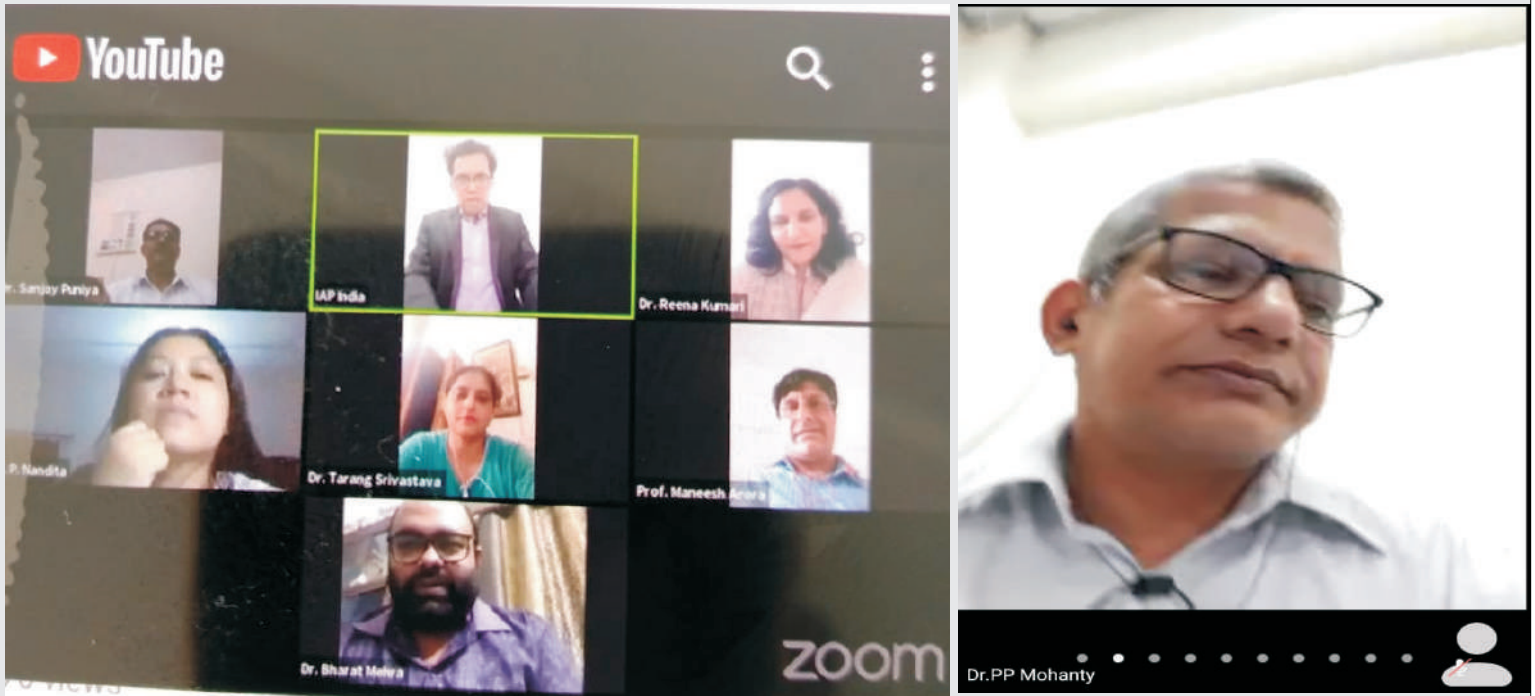
Teacher's Day
