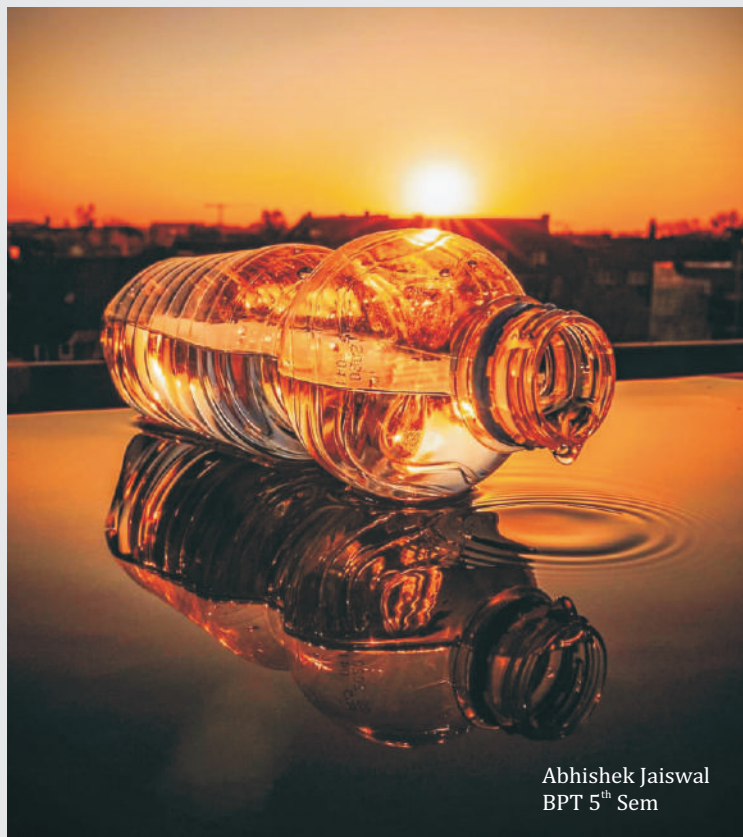


WELCOME FRESHERS
