NEW MEDICAL IMPLANT DEVICE TO TREAT EPILEPSY AND PARKINSONISM

The Researchers from the University of Cambridge, the ÉcoleNationaleSupérieure des Mines and INSERM in France, implanted a device into the brains of mice, and successfully demonstrated how an electronic device implanted directly into the brain can detect, stop and even prevent epileptic seizures. When the first signals of a seizure are detected, the device delivers a native brain chemical which stops the seizure from progressing. The results, reported in the journal Science Advances, could also be applied to other conditions including brain tumors and Parkinson's disease. Epilepsy is most commonly treated with anti-epileptic drugs, but these drugs often have serious side effects and they do not prevent seizures in three out of 10 patients. The researchers used a neurotransmitter which acts as a 'brake' at the source of the seizure, essentially signaling the neurons to stop firing and end the seizure. The drug is delivered to the affected region of the brain by a neural probe incorporating a tiny ion pump and electrodes to monitor neural activity. When the neural signal of a seizure is detected by the electrodes, the ion pump is activated, creating an electric field that moves the drug across an ion exchange membrane and out of the device, a process known as electrophoresis. The amount of drug can be controlled by tuning the strength of the electric field. In addition to be being able to control exactly when and how much drug is delivered, what is special about this approach is that the drugs come out of the device without any solvent. This prevents damage to the surrounding tissue and allows the drugs to interact with the cells immediately outside the device. The researchers found that seizures could be prevented with relatively small doses of drug representing less than 1% of the total amount of drug loaded into the device. This means the device should be able to operate for extended periods without needing to be refilled.



Dialogue Box



Machapuchare, Machhapuchchhre or Machhapuchhre (from Nepali meaning 'fishtail'), is a mountain in the Annapurna Himalayas of north central Nepal. It is ranked thirteenth most beautiful mountain in the world by Telegraph, UK in April, 2018. It is revered by the local population as particularly sacred to the god Shiva, and hence is off limits to climbing. Due to its southern position in the range, and the particularly low terrain that lies south of the Annapurna Himalayas, Machapuchare commands tremendous vertical relief in a short horizontal distance. This, combined with its steep, pointed profile, make it a particularly striking peak, despite a lower elevation than some of its neighbors. Its double summit resembles the tail of a fish, hence the name meaning "fish's tail" in Nepalese. It is also nicknamed the "Matterhorn of Nepal".
