However, the rigidity of a standardized curriculum raises concerns about its ability to address the diverse needs of learners. Individual learning styles, cultural backgrounds, and personal career aspirations vary significantly, making a one-size-fits-all approach potentially restrictive. Standardized models may inadvertently limit creativity, critical thinking, and adaptability-skills essential for success in modern careers. Furthermore, rapid advancements in technology and the evolving job market demand a more flexible and adaptive educational system. Striking a balance between standardization and personalized learning is crucial to ensuring that students not only meet academic benchmarks but also develop the critical, innovative, and problemsolving skills necessary for the challenges of the future.



#### PARTICIPANTS' ELIGIBILITY

1.Participants must be bona fide students of the participating institution and must be enrolled in undergraduate or postgraduate programs during the current academic session at any recognized college, institute, or university in India.

2. The debate competition will be conducted in two separate categories based on the language of delivery: English and Hindi

Participants must compete exclusively in the category they have selected.

#### **AWARDS AND HONOURS**

The prizes for each category (Hindi & English) are as follows:

- 1. Best Team Trophy Running Trophy (awarded based on the joint performance of both speakers in a team)
- 2. First Prize ₹20,000/- (for each category)
- 3. Second Prize ₹15,000/- (for each category)
- 4. Third Prize ₹10,000/- (for each category)

Additionally, a Certificate of Participation will be awarded to all participants.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. Participants may present their arguments in either English or Hindi, based on the category selected. However, speakers must strictly adhere to the chosen language throughout their speech.
- 2. Each team will be assigned a unique team code, and participants must refer to themselves using this code only. Disclosure of personal identities or university affiliations will result in immediate disqualification.
  - Each speaker will have a total of 6 minutes, allocated as follows:4 minutes for the main speech; 1 minute for the conclusion; 1 minute for the rebuttal.
  - A single bell will indicate the completion of 4 minutes.
  - A double bell will sound at 5 minutes, marking the end of the allocated time.
  - Exceeding the time limit will result in a negative marking.
- 3. The competition will be judged separately for English and Hindi categories.
- 4. Speakers are not allowed to carry notes, slips of paper, or any electronic gadgets onto the stage. Engaging in written debate or reading from any material will result in disqualification
- 5. The verdict of the judges will be final and binding. No protests or objections regarding the decision or procedure will be entertained.
- 6. This is a hybrid event:
  - The preliminary round will take place off-campus, at the participants' respective institutes or universities.
  - The final round will be conducted on-campus at SBSU

#### PRELIMINARY ROUND

All contestants must submit a self-recorded video (maximum 2 minutes in duration) by 25<sup>th</sup> March 2025 via email at debatesocietvsbs@amail.com.
